

In Art we create moulds, junk modelling and drawings of my family, my friends, my class, my favourite foods, my house, my journey to school as we discuss our similarities and differences. Artist - Yayoi Kusama is a Japanese contemporary artist who works primarily in sculpture.

We explore textures and autumn images with our collections. Learning to mix the colour orange. Vocab: form, sketch, texture, adhesive, effective, colour, primary, secondary, artist. In DT we learn the design - make - evaluate process making ginger bread men and our homes. Vocab; hygiene, germs, safety, cut shape, join

Saying hello and goodbye 'Bonjour

We all belong to groups e.g. family, brownies and our new school community and class. Some people belong to the Christian groups. Some Christian celebrations are birthdays, Harvest Vocab: celebration, festival, big days, important, Christian, say thank you, belief, amen.

Using programmable toys, children understand that an **algorithm** is a set of instructions to achieve an objective. Vocab: Device, tablet, computer, screen, mouse, keyboard, keys, buttons, mouse pad, internet, search engine, password, username, programming, reasoning, digital content, technology, electricity.

We love Google Earth & DigiMaps and send programmable toys all around Maps of our town finding our road, our school and other locations we may know.

**Vocab**: My road, my village, my town. Sittingbourne, Maidstone local town. London local City. Prepositional language to locate items near, far, up, down, over, under, left, right, horizon. Weather words - hot warm mild cold sunny cloudy.

We talk about the past and present events in our lives and in lives of family members. We discus chronology using everyday language, related to time. We order and sequence familiar, events; born, baby, toddler, nursery, starting school, making friends, school learning.

Vocab: before, after, then, next, after that, old, new, birthdays, starting school, past, future, when I was younger, when I was a baby, long ago, before I was born, when my parents were young, change

**Scientist**: Inez Fung is a Chinese atmosphere scientist who loves the learning about the weather.

We learn to identify and name wild and domesticated animals. Pets - cat dog horse rabbit gerbil hamster and

UK mammals - fox squirrel hedgehog badger bat rabbit. We compare environments' hamster cage vs fox underground tunnels. Explore hibernation - animal or plant sleeps (dormant) for the winter and migration

- animals move from colder countries to warmer countries.

We notice Autumn - season after summer and before winter. Leaves turn orange and fall from the trees. We investigate; Do trees ever change? Learn to collect evidence such as fallen leaves, conkers.
