Winters Walk and write down how you feel, use your 5 senses to help you.


What can you smell, what can you hear (near and far), What can you taste when you poke your tongue out? What Can you see?

Make an Ice Decoration to hang in a tree, what natural resources can you put in your design? Do not forget to add the string when its water. Leave outside overnight... Did it Freeze?



Make your own Christmas Tree. Go for a walk outside and find a fallen branch. Then take the branch home and place in a pot, you could use soil or stones to hold the branch in place in the pot. Then the fun begins create your own decorations to display on your new tree.

Make a Snow Flake Chain, Ask an adult when using scissors.



Feed the Birds – Make your own Winter Bird Feeders. As we now when it gets cold and becomes winter all animals struggle to find food. We can help by creating Wild Winter Bird Feeders, all you need is an apple and some sunflower seeds. Then it is time to get creative, what pattern will you come up with?
