


Respect the Forest School Equipment, most items we have are donated if we break items we will not have them to use, do you want Forest School to Progress, Develop and Thrive?

Safety and Risks at Forest School – **Be Risk Aware**, think about the Dangers and the harm that our choices and inappropriate behaviour could cause. **Remember out safety Blood Bubble** and use this not only at Forest School but throughout the school day to ensure that we are doing all that we can to ensure the safety of others



Nil by Mouth

We do not put anything in our mouths, we must wash our hands after our Forest School Session.



Don't touch anything we are unsure of, if we are unsure we ask an adult, some plants and wildlife can be dangerous and toxic so protect ourselves we do not touch anything we are unsure of we always check with an adult first.



Do NOT Run within Forest School – there are many different slip hazards up at Forest School, from tree roots to rabbit holes we do not want to fall and hurt ourselves, if you want to Run use an open space on the school field
